Aerial Lift Training Penticton - An aerial work platform is a mechanized access platform. This particular machinery provides access to otherwise not accessible areas for people or equipment. Likewise known as an aerial device or elevating work platform, the device is normally utilized to access high areas. Maintenance and construction staff often have to use aerial work platforms on the job. Firefighters use them for emergency access.

Meant for temporary use, aerial work platforms are different from elevators, which provide permanent access to high places. An aerial work platform is designed to be operated by a single individual, and can lift weights of not more than one ton. Various kinds have higher load limits. There are different kinds of aerial work platforms; for instance, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

A lot of the aerial work platforms are outfitted together with electrical outlets or compressed air connectors for power tools. For specialist tasks, such as lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform could come with special equipment.

Anyone required to operate an aerial lifting machine needs training, along with their bosses. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial device work areas likewise need to go through training. Trainees will become familiar with aerial lifting device operation. They will also learn the rules which apply to the safe operation of these machinery. Rules vary from province to province, and in federally regulated worksites.

Employees who work near or are required to be lifted by an aerial lifting device must be aware of all the potential dangers. In a general safety session, an Aerial Lift Training Video could be shown to educate all of the employees who are lifted by them or work near them.

Nearly all Aerial Lift Training Program will consist of modules that are focused on the following areas: hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Platform Positioning & Park Positioning and Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices. The program is intended to train staff on the safe operation of self-propelled, elevated work platforms and boom supported, self-propelled, elevated work platforms. Workers who complete the program will be given a certificate, signed by a person qualified to confirm the successful completion of a hands-on practical exam.
