Back injuries due to improper lifting methods are one more common danger.

Warehouse machines carries inherent hazards. Injuries or accidents could be caused by hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors if they are not operated correctly. Warehouse tools, like skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, need to be used carefully throughout unpacking, packing and loading.
